

Let's Brag About ME! Book

Supplies Needed:

- FOUR (4) - 5" charm squares per book
- FOUR (4) - 3 1/2" cardstock square template pages (see attached) per book
- Ribbon
- Yarn
- Buttons
- Brads (small works best)
- Stickers
- Other miscellaneous embellishments
- Scissors
- 3M Tacky Glue
- Photographs
- Small hole punch for brads

Building Your Brag Book

1. Start with the four charm squares and a piece of ribbon that is about an inch longer on both ends. Lay all pieces on top of each other, with the ribbon on the very top, and sew the book together using a zig-zag stitch.
2. Print the 3 1/2" square pages on cardstock and cut them out.
3. If you want to attach the cover page with brads, use the hold punch and punch holes in the 4 corners of the cover page cardstock. Line up the cover on the fabric and push the brads through each corner.
4. For the inside pages, using the cardstock and 3M Tacky Glue (sparingly, it doesn't take much), adhere them to the inside pages. The glue doesn't take long to dry, but you do need to try to keep the pages from sticking to each other while you wait for it to dry.
5. Now, it's time to add your photographs and embellishments! You can use brads, ribbons, yarn, stickers, buttons - anything that you can glue to decorate your pages will look great!
